



WHS Awareness – Half Day Course

Description:

This half (1/2) day face to face course will provide a general induction to the Work Health and Safety legislation, processes and best practices for all PCBUs, Workers and Managers. It is specifically designed to provide participants with an understanding of their roles and responsibilities pertaining to the Work Health and Safety legislation.

This is a condensed version of our one (1) day course.

Learning Outcomes:

On completion of this course participants will be able to:

- Understand the safe work approach to safety issues in the workplace.
- Comprehend the general principles of the Work Health and Safety legislation, with a focus on their duties and obligations.
- Identify hazards in their workplace and undertake the process of elimination or minimisation.
- Understand the consultation and communication processes, including Health & Safety Representatives and Health & Safety Committees.
- Commence applying the Risk Management process:
 - Identify hazards and control risks
 - Assess risks
 - Implement the Hierarchy of Controls
 - Develop WHS plans.
