



NDIS Emergency & Disaster Management – Half Day Course

Description:

In response to the impact of COVID-19, as well as a number of recent natural disasters including bushfires and floods, the new NDIS Emergency and Disaster Management Practice Standard was introduced in November 2021.

This was one of three new NDIS Practice Standards that were introduced at the time. It was added into the NDIS Practice Standards so that providers ensure they have measures in place that will enable the continuity of each participant's critical supports in the event of an emergency or disaster.
