

Description:

WHS/OHS for Managers & Supervisors is a vital training program that enhances the capabilities of managerial staff in maintaining and promoting a safe workplace. It will equip Managers and Supervisors with the essential skills and knowledge to be prepared to fulfill their WHS responsibilities, effectively manage risks, and lead their teams towards a culture of safety.

Learning Outcomes:

- WHS/OHS concepts and why workplace safety is important including key statistics from SafeWork Australia.
- Work Health and Safety laws and regulations, including key terminology and definitions.
- Their specific roles and responsibilities in maintaining a safe workplace including the concept of due diligence.
- The legislative framework and the roles of regulatory bodies and enforcement agencies.
- Understand and apply a number of consultation, co-operation and communications strategies for a safer workplace.
- Apply the principles of risk management, including identifying workplace hazards, conducting risk assessments and implementing risk control measures (hierarchy of controls).
- Develop and implement strategies to make their workplace a safer environment.
